This program is suitable for those who wish to work as a teacher in an early years setting and takes 8 months to complete

The IPC's Early Childhood Education Theory and Application Program-Level 3 prepares you to qualify as an Early Years Teacher for British, American and other International curricula. Approved and accredited by KHDA and Ministry of Social Affairs-UAE, IPC's Level 3 training program give you wider career options to work in nurseries, kindergartens and ELCs across the UAE. The program is designed to enhance and increase the knowledge, skills and experiences critical to providing children and families with high quality Early Childhood Education. This program takes into account the most recent developments in Early Childhood Education and looks at trends that will shape the future of preschool teaching.

On completion, participants will have a sound understanding of child development, be able to create positive environments, effectively facilitate curriculum, provide developmentally appropriate assessments and establish and maintain meaningful relationships with children and families, for children up to 6 years of age.

IPC's Level 3 teacher training program, consists of 8 Foundation Modules.

- 1. Child Growth and Development
- 2. Environments for Early Learners
- Curriculum and Lesson Planning for Early Learner Classrooms
- 4. Observation, Documentation and Assessment in Early Childhood
- 5. Language and Literacy Development in Early Learners
- 6. Ethics and Professionalism in Early Education and Care
- 7. Family Engagement in Early Education Settings
- 8. Health & Safety

In addition, workshop attendance will qualify for the minimum professional development requirement for teachers, as prescribed by the Ministry of Social Affairs, UAE.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Participants must be employed in an Early Years environment, with minimum ECE experience of at least six months, prior to joining the program.

In order to receive the IPC Level 3 Certificate participants will be required to:

- Attend a total of 11 workshops
- Successfully complete Assignments and Assessments for each foundation module
- · Attend workshops on Child Protection and CPR/First Aid, or provide proof of prior certification.

Participants will be observed in their work environment, once they have completed their submissions for the 8 foundation modules.

Participants should be prepared for review, rigorous discussions and research of the course content and materials. Computer and internet access is required to review course materials and submit assignments.

ASSIGNMENTS

Each foundation module will require participants to put in approximately 30 hours of time (includes workshops, self-study, and assignments). Assignments marks per module are given below:
